## 2004 VSA arts Playwright Discovery Award

**Students:** The VSA arts Playwright Discovery Award invites middle and high school students to write from their own experience or about an experience in the life of another person or fictional character, in how disability affects their lives and the lives of others. Young playwrights with and without disabilities are encouraged to submit a script. Entries must be postmarked no later than **April 15, 2004**.

**Teachers:** Apply or nominate a teacher for the 2004 Playwright Discovery Teacher Award, which is awarded to a middle or high school teacher who creatively bring disability awareness to the classroom through the art of playwrighting. Nominations must be postmarked no later than **April 15, 2004**.
